Caring For Your Child's Custom Orthotics

- Allied
- Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Avoid soaking or machine washing.
- Check monthly for wear, damage, or fit issues. We recommend purchasing the Assured Orthotic Replacement Coverage to protect your against the unforeseen replacement costs due to outgrowth, accidental destruction, and lost or stolen orthotics.
- If your child gets new shoes, make sure to transfer your orthotics over; consult your podiatrist for proper shoe fitting.
- O not attempt to trim or alter your child's orthotics. Adjustments are available and should only be done by your podiatrist or Allied OSI Labs.

- 1-Year Rescan

Contact Your Podiatrist Before Scheduled Follow-Ups If:

- Your child displays or complains about discomfort, or if there is any swelling and/or redness.
- O You notice any new instability or increased tripping.
- O Your child has a sudden growth spurt.
